Kama'aina Kids, a non-profit, multi-service organization dedicated to serving our island community through quality child care has been selected as the private provider to manage Nuuanu Elementary A+ program for the 2010 - 2011 school year.

Kama'aina Kids will provide a variety of educational, recreational and enrichment experiences in which children can develop a positive sense of self, community, and the earth. Our adult group leaders are trained in school age care, child development, recreational programming and are certified in first aid and C.P.R.

First established in 1987 as a single summer day camp with 45 students, Kama'aina Kids now serves over 9,500 children every day and is one of Hawaii's largest private child care providers. A+ tuition rates will remain the same as long as the Department of Education keeps the current rates. Private providers such as Kama'aina Kids must strictly adhere to the tuition rates established by the Department of Education.

Many of you may already know me, as I have worked with the Aikane O Nuuanu Intersession Programs for the last few years. I am very excited to continue working with the students and families of Nuuanu Elementary School this upcoming year. I will be available to answer any questions you may have on Wednesday, July 28th between 4:30 p.m - 6:00 p.m in the cafeteria. I look forward to meeting with you at that time.

The cost for the A+ is set by the state and is currently priced at \$55.00 per month. This may change sometime during the school year should the BOE decide.
